Proposed Duty Suspension Flumiclorac pentyl ester HTS#2925.19.4200 Flumiclorac pentyl ester / Resource®

General Information about Valent:

Valent U.S.A. is a California corporation headquartered in Walnut Creek, California. The company has 122 employees in California and 244 nationwide.

Valent is requesting a duty suspension on the active chemical ingredient that is formulated into its product Resource®.

Product Description:

Resource® is a member of the N-phenylphthalimide class of chemistry. The approved American National Standard Institute (ANSI) common name for Resource® is flumiclorac pentyl ester. The full name of the active ingredient is pentyl [2-chloro-5-(cyclohex-1-ene-1,2-dicarboximido)-4-fluorophenoxy] acetate (HTS#2925.19.4200).

Resource® is a fast-acting, postemergence broadleaf herbicide that can be used in both corn and soybeans. Resource® provides control of certain weeds, especially velvetleaf, at very low rates.

End Product Use:

Resource® is targeted at the corn and soybean markets for velvetleaf control. Also, Resource® is positioned as a tank-mix partner for postemergence control of velvetleaf in soybeans and corn with the widest window of application of any velvetleaf product and no crop rotation restrictions.

Flumiclorac pentyl ester is also one of the two (2) active ingredients in Stellar® a post-emergence herbicide. This premix with lactofen (Cobra®) provides a lower use rate of each individual active ingredient for use in the soybean market for control of a variety of weeds, including waterhemp, pigweed, velvetleaf and common ragweed.
