Eye: Product produces mild, reversible eye irritation in albino rabbits.
Skin: Product is a moderate skin irritant for rabbits. Acute dermal LD₅₀ >5,000 mg/kg (rabbits). Primary skin irritation index = 2.29 (rabbits).
Ingestion & Inhalation: Oral LD₅₀ > 5,000 mg/kg. Encapsulation greatly reduces the toxicity and irritation potential of the active ingredients. When sprayed, produces particle size larger than considered respirable.

SECTION 8: SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

Precautions to be taken in handling and storage: *Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:* CAUTION - Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Do not apply to humans, their clothing or bedding. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not contaminate food or use on household pets. Cover fish tanks prior to application. Do not apply this product in patient rooms while occupied or in any rooms while occupied by the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Avoid contamination of food, feedstuffs, or water supply. Do not contaminate food preparation surfaces, kitchen utensils, dishes or feed storage containers. Any food/feed contact surfaces and cooking utensils in the treatment area should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using.
